

Public Education Advocates

The Public Education Advocates (PEA) committee of North Central WEA UniServ was established by the 1994 Representative Assembly to inform our communities about the vital service that public education provides in our state.

What does this mean to you at the local level? Think about a project or evening that includes parents and students: a science fair, math night, delivering pumpkin pies to senior citizens...

Think about the money you usually spend out of pocket to involve parents and kids in your school. Well, you don't have to spend your own money. Local associations may access a reserve especially for the purpose of parent/community outreach in support of public schools.

Every month \$.35 of your local dues is put into a reserve. You think of a project, contact your local president, and fill out a form with the amount of money you need. The local president signs it and sends the form to Laine at the North Central WEA UniServ office.

Upon receiving money and completing your project, tell your parents that your local education association promoted and sponsored the activity. This encourages community awareness and support for public schools which is our goal!
